

**Nui Bezaire, Homeless Programs Coordinator, Napa County HHSA**

Nui has worked to end homelessness for over 10 years, starting at the Downtown Women's Center (DWC) in the skid row community of Los Angeles. In various roles during her seven years of service to DWC, she designed programs, was integral to the organization's relocation and expansion of permanent housing and services, and led the launch of one of DWC's social enterprise boutiques. She then joined the Corporation for Supportive Housing, providing technical assistance and consulting services to communities nationwide on homeless systems change, vulnerable populations and supportive housing. Nui recently joined Napa County Health and Human services as the county and city's first Homeless Program Coordinator, to implement major homeless systems change efforts such as a flexible housing funding pool and the Whole Person Care pilot. Nui holds a Bachelor's degree in Legal Studies from UC Santa Cruz and an MBA from Willamette University.
