Please join us for the webinar, *Talking About Race and Racism with Clients: Challenges, Benefits & Strategies for Fostering Meaningful Dialogue*, the fifth webinar in the five (5) webinar series, *Eliminating Inequities in Behavioral Health Care*. **The goal of this webinar is to build participant skills to effectively engage in conversations about race with their clients that is both healing, and ultimately, promotes racial equity.** The target audience for the series includes behavioral health care leadership, administrators and managers, ethnic service managers, peer professionals, clinical supervisors, clinicians/direct care providers, and care managers.

Learning Objectives include:

1. Participants are able to recite one or more cultural formulation interview questions for eliciting the client's understanding of the problem and avoiding pathologizing experiences of racism among behavioral health clients who are BIPOC.
2. Participants are able to cite at least two symptoms of "acute racism reaction" that are important to consider when conducting assessments and treating behavioral health clients who are BIPOC.
3. Participants are able to discuss one or more factors to consider when assessing the value for treatment of initiating a dialogue about race, racial identity and/or racism with behavioral health clients who are BIPOC.
