- ◆ Descriptions of the various county behavioral health funding streams and how they can work together to reduce disparities in access to community mental health and integrated care services.
- ◆ The impact of behavioral health fiscal funding, policy and reporting on the delivery of mental health and dual diagnosis services in small, medium and large counties.

This two-day Institute will provide county behavioral health fiscal leaders with critical information and tools to stay up-to-date on today's rapid changes in healthcare. Participants will hear from experts on behavioral healthcare finance and policy.
