Camy Rightmier moved to Siskiyou County in 1999 and began her career with the County. She has worked for various departments over the last 19 years, from the auditor's office to Sheriff, taking from each position many unique job experiences and different perspectives before settling down at Behavioral Health in 2013. Since then, she has been involved in the planning, writing and implementing of five MHSA annual updates and two 3-year plans. She has been instrumental in creating and managing a Full Service Partnership program for Adults, Older Adults and Youth that has almost 200 members. She was also the driving force behind

research and development of the County's first wellness center, Six Stones Wellness Center, which opened its doors in December 2015. She is co-chair of the Department's Cultural and Linguistic Competence Committee and a member of the Area Agency on Aging, Planning Service Area 2 Advisory Council. She is also fully trained and certified as the County's Planning Section Chief for the Emergency Operations Center; a role she took on at the Sheriff's Department and continues to fill in the event the County is involved in a disaster.
