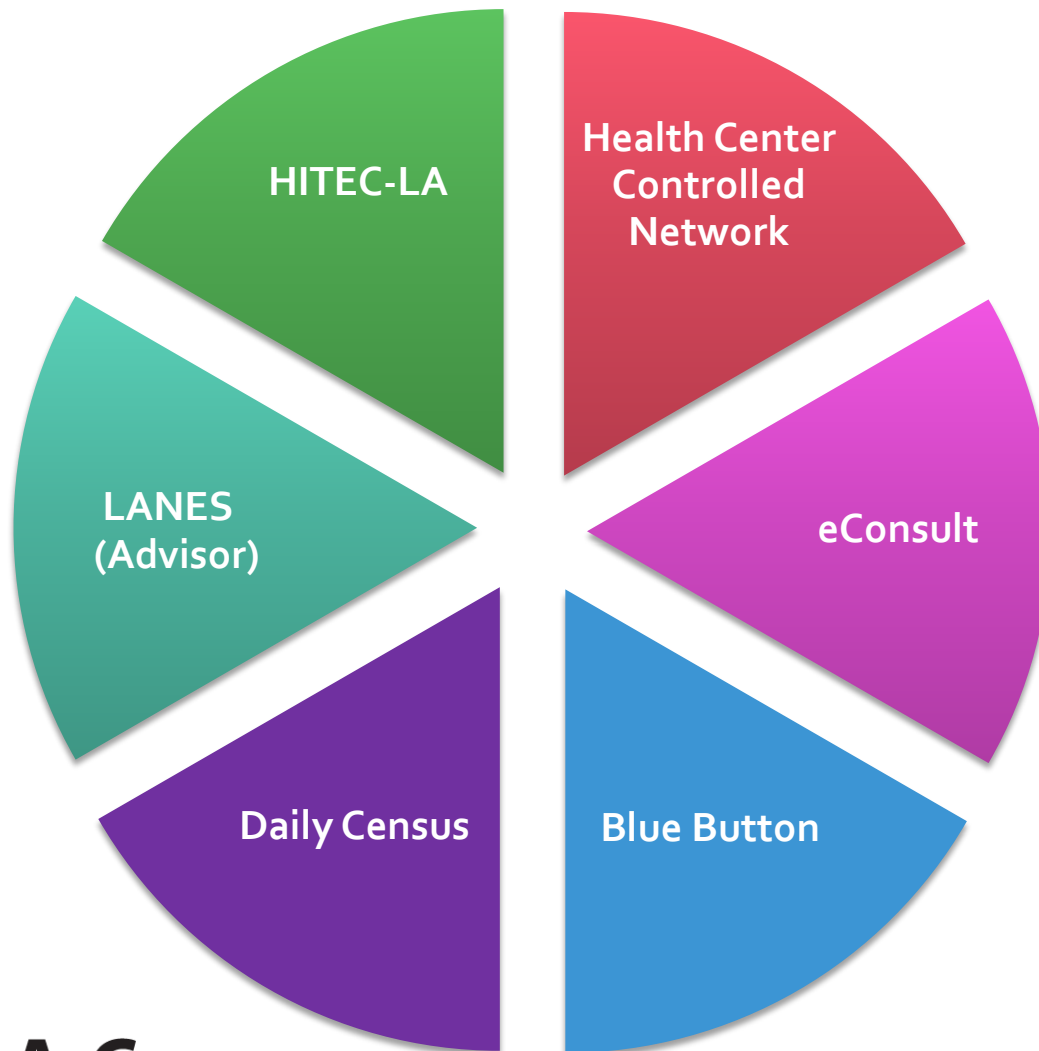
Where We've Been

- California received \$50M+ to provide free assistance to 11,000 providers over four years
- Four RECs: HITEC-LA, CalHIPSO, COREC, CRIHB
- Progress
 - 9,000 at meaningful use – over 85% of goal
 - \$600M incentives paid as of February
- HITEC-LA and CalHIPSO awarded no cost extensions into 2015; COREC and CRIHB TBD

Where We're Going

- RECs committed to continuing HIT support
- RECs undergoing transformation
 - HITEC-LA: Six main HIT initiatives supporting care coordination
 - CalHIPSO: Meaningful use and other HIT services
 - CalOptima: HIE/interoperability to secure data exchange/messaging; EHR and attestation support for specialists; eConsult/eHealth; meaningful use Stage 2
 - CRIHB under national program
- Behavioral health support looks promising

Health Care Reform Driving HIT for Behavioral Health



eConsult

- Web-based system that allows PCPs and specialists to securely share health information and discuss patient care
 - Members/Patients: 700,000
 - Sites: 194
 - Users: 4,900 (2,300 PCPs)
 - eConsults: 93,000
 - Networks: 2 (HCLA & DHS)
- Begin to use eConsult platform for “eManagement” to support new Medi-Cal behavioral health benefit
 - Pairs PCPs with Behavioral Health Specialist Reviewers to assist in managing treatment of members with behavioral health disorders
 - Ensures members see right behavioral health provider first time
 - Integrates eConsult into model of care, protocols, and desk procedures

Blue Button

- Web based patient access to medical records
 - VA first offered Blue Button to members
 - CMS made Blue Button available to Medicare beneficiaries
- L.A. Care develops first Medi-Cal Blue Button
- Pilot
 - Targets members with multiple prescriptions written by multiple providers
 - High volume L.A. Care small practices on EHRs
 - Four providers including psychiatrist serving 5,000 L.A. Care members
- Why it will help behavioral health providers
 - Patients partnering with doctors
 - Prescription history
