HOUSING FIRST MODEL VS. TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

What is Housing First Model?

- An approach to quickly and successfully connect individuals and families experiencing homelessness to permanent housing without preconditions and barriers to entry.

What is transitional housing?

- A project designed to provide housing and appropriate supportive services to homeless persons, to facilitate movement to independent living. (less than 24 mos)





HOUSING FIRST MODEL WITHIN OUR TAY SERVICES

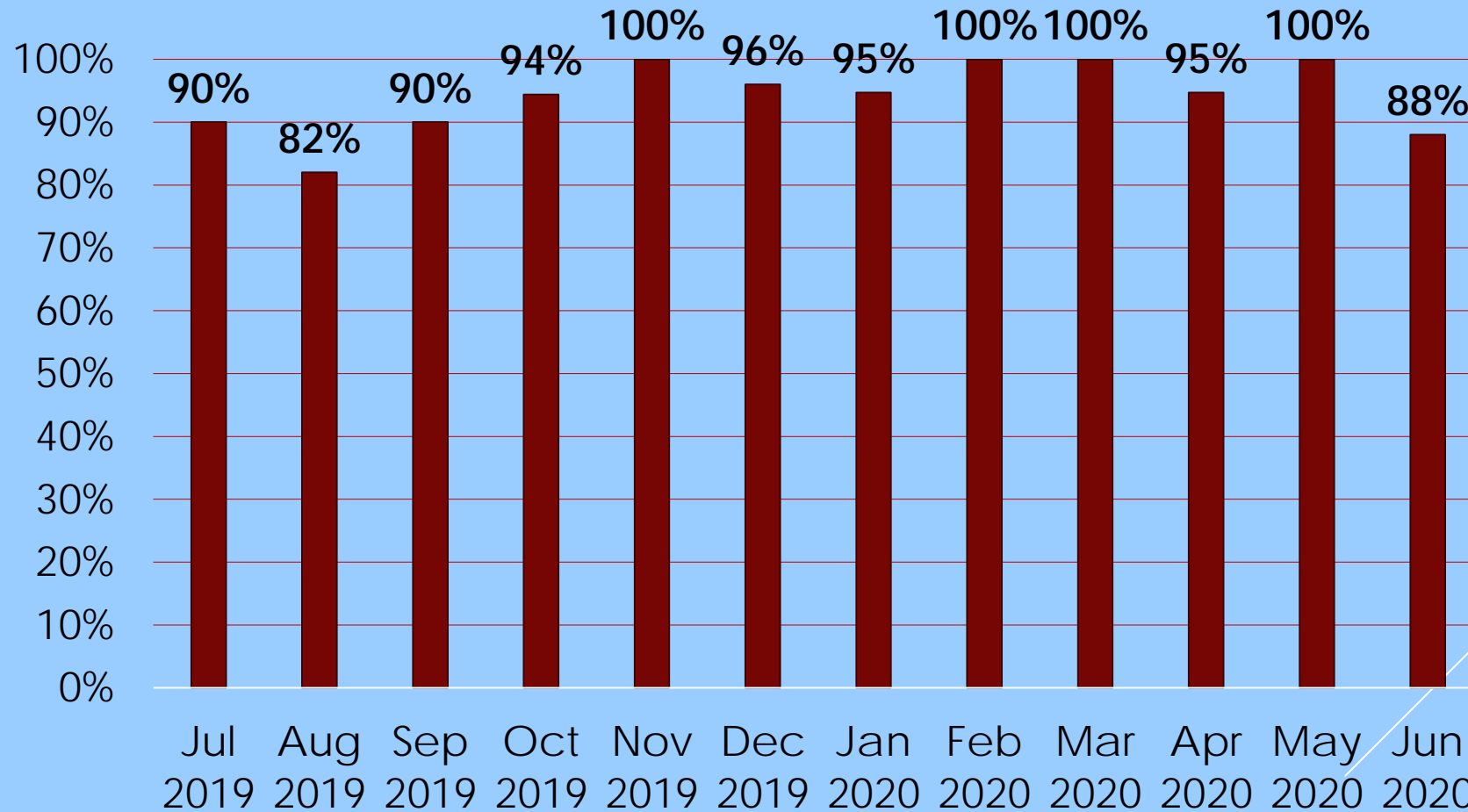
- How do we do Housing First?
 - **Housing** – immediate access to housing with no preconditions
 - **Choice** – youth choice and self-determination
 - **Recover** – recovery orientation
 - **Support** – individualized and person-driven support
 - **Community** – social and community integration
