As part of that work, Filomena was the lead drafter of the recent amendments to the PEI and INN regulations adopted by the Commission in January 2018, which, if approved by the Office of Administrative Law, will go into effect in July 2018. Prior to joining the MHSOAC Filomena was in private practice. She has also taught ethics for twenty years at Lincoln Law School of Sacramento. Filomena received her law degree from the University of California, Davis, School of Law.
